

- Customized trainings available to building departments on local reach code implementation and enforcement




Energy Code Trainings

Municipal ZNE/ZNC Technical Assistance

- Technical Assistance: BayREN provides free engineering technical assistance and resources to help local governments save energy and money while reducing their carbon footprints by moving towards Zero Net Energy (ZNE) or Zero Net Carbon (ZNC) with their buildings.
- Municipal ZNE RFP and OPR Template Language: Request for proposal (RFP) and owner project requirements (OPR) template language for local governments to encourage developers to construct new municipal buildings to ZNE.



Decarbonization Framework for Existing Buildings

EXISTING POLICIES

- Energy benchmarking
- 100% Renewable Electricity Ordinance

NEW STRATEGIES

- Help owners plan to invest over time
- Require decarbonization by 2035 and regular progress reports
- Invest compliance fees in decarbonization of affordable housing


